

Why Should I Rotate My Tires?

The simple answer is to extend the useful life of your tires. The purpose of rotating your tires on a regular basis is to achieve more uniform wear across the tread on all tires on the vehicle. Before rotating the tires, refer to your vehicle's Owner's Manual for rotation recommendations, or just stop by any Big O Tires location. If there is no period specified, then you should have the tires rotated every 8047 kilometres or sooner if signs of irregular or uneven tire wear appear. If your tires do show irregular or uneven tire wear, Big O Tires can check your vehicle for any misalignment, imbalance or other mechanical problem at the time that the technician rotates your tires.
